

PROGRAM

At Sri Chaitanya, we believe that school is an important part in the community. Hence, we conduct events where children can learn through multiple interactions with the community and benefits through efforts and interactions with our staff and children. The various celebrations and events at the school are designed to foster connections amongst the school community and external community members to develop good education. As part of our efforts to inculcate in students the appreciation of and respect for India's rich heritage diversity and to reinforce in them national pride and respect for all the school celebrates several functions including.

Celebrations/Festivals and National events: -

Krishna Jayanti -On the occasion of Janmashtami, the children of 1 to 5 took it upon themselves to celebrate the birth of Lord Krishna with performances and storytelling. The students welcomed with an introduction with Lord Krishna with a short dance & song. They were dressed like 'Natkath' and girls were beautifully 'Gopis'. They song melodious tune and enacted a requesting sense little Krishna.

Independence Day-

Students organize a flag hosting ceremony . The air is filled with patriotic feelings that emanate from various songs aired on the campus radio. As the tricolour goes up atop the administrative building of administrative block all the students salute with reverence and pride and sing the national anthem. The programme consists of patriotic songs sung by students and speeches eulogizing the great sacrifices made by our freedom fighters followed by the Principal's message.

Ganesh Chaturthi-

During the Navratri festival (nine auspicious nights) prayers are offered to the Mother Goddess (Shakti). Students are dressed in traditional attire and dance to rhythmic tunes for the traditional ‘Dandia’ dance.

Diwali

is popularly known as the “Festival of Lights”, it is the most significant Indian festival that falls during the mid-year vacation (in the first half of November). While students are busy lighting up their homes, the staff at Chaitanya light up the campus with oil lamps and offer prayers to the Goddess of prosperity, for the welfare of all the students.

Childrens day –

Children’s day was celebrated with full fervour at Sri Chaitanya School, on 14th of November. This day which is also the birthday of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, the first Prime Minister of India is celebrated as a tribute to him.
