

PROGRAMS

At Sri Chaitanya, we believe that school is an important part in the community. Hence, we conduct events where children can learn through multiple interactions with the community and benefits through efforts and interactions with our staff and children. The various celebrations and events at the school are designed to foster connections amongst the school community and external community members to develop good education.

As part of our efforts to inculcate in students the appreciation of and respect for India's rich heritage diversity and to reinforce in them national pride and respect for all the school celebrates several functions including.

Celebrations/Festivals and National events: -

***Education day** was celebrated on birth day of Perunthalaivar Kamarajar, former Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, on the 15th day of July, as a token of gratitude we celebrate in Sri Chaitanya as "Educational Development Day". Beginning with a eulogy of Kamara jar, the students gave speech on education and skits were enacted explaining the importance of education.*

***Krishna Jayanti** -- On the occasion of Janmashtami the children of 1 to 5 took it upon themselves to celebrate the birth of Lord Krishna with performances and storytelling. The students welcomed with an introduction with Lord Krishna with a short dance & song. They were dressed like 'Natkath' and girls were beautifully 'Gopis'. They song melodious tune and enacted a requesting sense little Krishna.*

***Independence Day:** Students organize a flag hosting ceremony. The air is filled with patriotic feelings that emanate from various songs aired on the campus radio. As the tri-colour goes up atop the administrative building of administrative block all the students salute with reverence and pride and sing the national anthem. The programme consists of patriotic songs sung by students and speeches eulogizing the great sacrifices made by our freedom fighters followed by the Principal's message.*

***Ganesh Chaturthi** -- Echoing the sentiment "festival promote feeling of social cohesion and communal harmony", the primary school celebrated the Ganesh Chaturthi. The students made little Ganesh idols and danced to loud music for*

the celebrations and revelry. Students sang bhajans with much fervour and devotion to the lord Ganesha.

National Sports Day -- Hockey Player Dhyan chand's birth anniversary is observed on 29th August as National Sports Day. As a token of gratitude, We Chaitanya celebrated with the theme FIX and FIT .Followed by March past, sports activities and prize distribution.

Teachers' Day Celebration -- On 6th of September our school gave a grand reception to the respected teachers on the occasion of Teachers' Day, the auspicious occasion of Dr. Sarvepalli Radha Krishnan's birthday. The students of class high school arranged the whole programme. They beautifully decorated the Hall of the school with flowers and garlands. They also organized a cultural function. The function started with a dance performance by the students of primary. Then the musical band of our school performed on the stage. The students of few classes showed their talents through mimicry of the teachers. The teachers felt that this programme was a treat to watch. Renowned teachers, present and retired, of the area were among the dignitary's present.

Hindi diwas -- Hindi Diwas on 14 September 2018 was celebrated with great enthusiasm. The students of primary section took part whole heartedly and highlighted the significance of the language in connecting the citizens of India, through their dance-drama and recitation. Students were oriented about the importance of Hindi language and how celebrating the day helps in sustaining traditional values and glorifying them to reinforce the languages' importance.

Dussera -- "The festival of Victory," is celebrated for 10 days in all parts of the subcontinent. The festival is celebrated on the tenth day of the Ashwini month, according to the Shaka Hindu Calendar (around October) and symbolizes the victory of Good over evil. During the Navratri festival (nine auspicious nights) prayers are offered to the Mother Goddess (Shakti). Students are dressed in traditional attire and dance to rhythmic tunes for the traditional 'Dandia' dance.

Diwali is popularly known as the "Festival of Lights", it is the most significant Indian festival that falls during the mid-year vacation (in the first half of November). While students are busy lighting up their homes, the staff at Chaitanya light up the campus with oil lamps and offer prayers to the Goddess of prosperity, for the welfare of all the students.

National Unity Day or Rashtriya Ekta Diwas -- National Unity Day was celebrated at 31st October 2018 at sri Chaitanya School, It is celebrated to commemorate the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel who really

unified the country. Special assembly was conducted by the pupils of classes along with programs narrating about the day and the leaders. The students gave a message to the students that we should all walk on the footsteps of Sh. Patel because National Unity is of prime importance for the progress, security and development of a nation. The fellow members' teachers and Principal Ma'am applauded the efforts of the students and expressed her heartfelt desire to see our countrymen united and not differentiate each other on the basis of caste or religion as National Unity is our most priceless asset.

Children's day Children's day was celebrated with full fervour at Sri Chaitanya School, on 14th of November. This day which is also the birthday of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, the first Prime Minister of India is celebrated as a tribute to him. He was known for his relentless effort to increase awareness of the rights, care and education of children. The Republic Day of India is a National festival to mark the adoption of the Constitution of India and transition of India from a British Dominion to an Independent Republic on January 26th 1950. As 26th January approaches, the spirit of patriotism and competition is high among the students of Chaitanya. The 'Republic Day Run' is flagged at the campus and followed by March past igniting the spirit of the tri-colour on this occasion.

Field trip students: - Exchange program Sri Chaitanya non-experimental research to provide students with experience outside their everyday activities field trip are a way of enhancing class room learning by making real world connections. The students reinforce experimental and contextual learning. Activities to promote awareness: -

***Eco day** -- The children expressively and effectively need to cherish and pay homage to Mother earth as 'She' is all we have. The week commenced with the house captions about like genesis of environment day and emphasizing need to pledge one support to save one natural resources. They participated different activities that made posters with slogans, colourful banners and learned to make garbage bags through paper folding in accumulation with this day we had mentors for teaching our students on recycling. This year on the discriminating use of plastic and focused on the harmful effects of plastic in environment. In par with it we have two bins in each class room for degradable and nondegradable wastes. Videos were played on kinds of pollution of and the ways to beat it.*

Sri Chaitanya techno school, Kanakapura Road Branch celebrated the essence of International Yoga Day by organizing a special yoga week from 18th to 23rd June, 2019 with a series of activities in the school premises. Field trips offers students a unique cultural learning experience. It allows students to be involved in new environments, key to encouraging curiosity about a given subject. Primary Students of Sri Chaitanya were taken to bakery where the kids met the bakers and enhanced their knowledge in baking of cake.

English expo

Offering children opportunities to appreciate different types of literature, increase the knowledge about writers/literary figures and literary classics and showcase their own work. Children develop interest in reading, writing and enjoy taking part in debates and quiz. The students presented their model and explain the interpretation orally to their audiences. The use and benefits of the model displayed and students are asked to answer all the queries. The students also displayed model and explained with the use of multimedia technology like PowerPoint presentations. Exhibitions serve as an influential platform to come together, share and build long-lasting relationships.

Maths expo

Certain qualities that are nurtured by mathematics are power of reasoning, creativity, abstract or spatial thinking, critical thinking, problem-solving ability and even effective communication skills. Abacus education improves the skills of Visualization (photographic memory), Concentration, Listening Skills, Memory, Speed, Accuracy, Creativity, Self Confidence, and Self-Reliance resulting in Whole Brain Development. Abacus based Arithmetic functions; calculations thereof enhance Concentration levels. Considering all the mile stones sri Chaitanya has made it mandatory to its students from class 1 to class V and Vedic Mathematics for classes VI to VIII.
